Mission Statement:

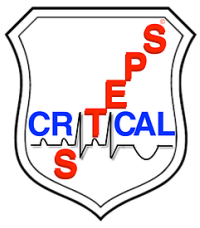
To deliver an exemplary course using hands-on procedural skills and simulation targeted at doctors-in- training, to help them develop skills and abilities in their management of the critically ill patient.
